

Chocolate Factory - Print and Play

Supplies You'll Need:

- 1 - 10" x 12" Gray Card Stock (Board)
- 7 - 8.5" x 11" White Card Stock (Factories, Trucks, Clipboard, Recipes, Warehouses)
- 17 - 8.5" x 11" White Paper (Cards - Front, Rules, Tokens)
- 6 - 8.5" x 11" Brown Card Stock (Cards - Back)
- 54 - Penny Card Sleeves (Cards)
- 120 - Circular 3/4" Wooden Discs (Goods Tokens)
- 8 - Meeples (Worker Pawns)
- 15 - Pennies (Coins)
- 1 - 8-Sided Die

Instructions

Print the files on the appropriate paper, then get ready to cut and glue!

Board

Glue the cut out factory to one side of the gray board, and glue the other factory to the other. Glue one warehouse into each corner on the front side, then do the same for the flip side. Make sure the warehouses are in the same positions on the flip side so players will still be sitting in front of their warehouses when it is flipped.

Tokens

Use regular glue and a paint brush to apply the token labels to the wooden tokens. Alternatively you can print on sticker paper.

The tokens have a Front / Back layout:

- Sugar / Sugar
- Cacao / Chocolate
- Undecorated Candy / Decorated Candy

Clipboard

Cut these out and glue them back to back.

Cards

Put the front and the back in a sleeve. The cardstock on the back should be enough to keep it firm.
